Course Description: A beautiful 5.6 mile circuit with a steep climb, rolling hills, and a fast downhill section. The loop is within the Flint Ridge Community on good roads with limited traffic.

Directions: From Tulsa, take Highway 412 East to Kansas, OK. Go South on 10/59 through a flashing red light. Continue south for 5 miles to front gates of Flint Ridge on the Left. Approx location: 24300 Flint Ridge Dr, Kansas, OK or 36.144309, -94.779593

Registration: Online at SportsBaseOnline.com for the fees listed in the table below. There are NO additional fees or surcharges to register online. There is an additional **\$10 fee for day-of registration**. Day-of registration and packet pick-up opens at 8:00am. Registration will be open all day and closes 15 minutes before each race.

Oklahoma State Road Race Championship



Each category listed is racing for Oklahoma State Championship medals; 3 places deep. First place in each category is eligible to win an Oklahoma State Championship jersey; **EXCEPT there is no jersey available for category 5 men.

Only entries with an annual USAC license that lists Oklahoma as a state of residence are eligible for state championship medals and jerseys. Entries from other states or that have a one-day license may race for cash or merchandise prizes only. One-day and annual USAC licenses will be on sale. One-day license entries are restricted to Masters, Juniors, Women 4, and Men 5.

Junior and master racers do not have to be of the same category as the field that they are combined with. Anyone eligible to race in two categories with the same start time may enter both categories for an additional \$5.

Categories that are listed to start together will be competing for a combined cash or merchandise prize list. Any prizes not claimed by the end of the event will be forfeited.

Races will be held rain or shine. Parents or guardians must sign a release for entries under 18.

Promoter reserves the right to adjust course length and schedule. Fields with fewer than 7 competitors may be combined with other fields.

Team Wheels in / Team Wheels out unless the Chief Referee deems there are enough for neutral wheels.
