The Bicycle Racing Association of Oklahoma would like to offer the use of BRAO owned equipment (camera, lap board, etc) to BRAO member clubs for use at events geared towards practice and skill development at a lower than normal cost. This allows a weekly criterium, time trial series, or skills clinic to take place without the overhead of purchasing equipment or high rental costs.

The fee is \$10 per day. Arrangements and cost of transporting equipment to and from each event is up to the event promoter. In order to qualify for this discounted rate, please submit the completed form and checklist. An event flier should be included if available.

- Entry fee will be no greater than \$15 per person per day.
- Cumulative prize-list for the event will be no greater than \$150 per day. This is to include both cash and retail value of any merchandise. *
- Event will not conflict with other BRAO endorsed events. Standard BRAO events will always have precedent over practice events.
- Event must be insured through USAC as a competitive or non-competitive event.
- Each club listed as a sponsoring club of the event must be a member in good standings with BRAO.

I assure that every item on the checklist is true and accurate and that not upholding these guidelines for my event will void this agreement and risk jeopardizing my club's membership in the Bicycle Racing Association of Oklahoma.

* An event is welcome to offer primes, daily prizes, end of series prizes, or any combination therein. The total primes and prizes for one day may not total over \$150. If an end-of series prize is offered, it may not be over \$150 times the number of days permitted, minus any other prizes offered during that time. For ex: if an event paid out \$80 for each race day during a four week period, then an end of series prize-list may not be more than $(\$150 - \$80) \times 4 = \$280$.
